II. PARTICIPANTS

1. Participants are children who practice Karate-Do and respect the rules of competition based on WTKF Competition Rules.
2. There are no limits of participating athletes/teams from one country/clubs.
3. In case of insufficient number of contestants for a particular category (minimum 8 athletes per category), they will be incorporated in another group of similar age and grade.
4. All countries must bring their national flag.
5. National Federation must grant each registered participant or visitor his or her own insurance.

C. Participation Fee

Athletes

EUR 50 for athlete (only one fee, and athlete can participate in all competitions).

Registration fees for all athletes paid to the TOC at the Tournament Office at latest two day before competition (until Wednesday - 12th October 2016).

Coaches

One coach per 15 kids is free of charge. Extra coach for a team is 50 EUR.

Photographer

One photographer per national federation is free of charge.
Extra photographer is 50 EUR.
