Additional Regulations for children competitions

All children age categories (2004 and younger) will be divided into several (min. 2) subgroups according to their rank (**lower Kyus**, **medium Kyus** and **higher Kyus**). Precise division is to be defined according to the preliminary applications and will be announced not later than April 7, 2017. In case of insufficient number of participants in a category (less than 3) or unproportional division of the subgroups the T.O.C. can change and combine the subgroups.

In **Individual Kata** flag system judging (Kata performed in pairs) will be used including the finals in case of number of participants in category exceeding 12 (if less, point system will be used – semi-final and final)¹. Judge will announce Kata name up to lowest rank of athlete on tatami (Kyu or Dan). Because of differences in ranking-colour systems used in different schools and organizations we ask you to pay attention to the fact, that judges will use the belt colour as a criterion in order to name a Kata in each pair of competitors. Athletes have to be ready to perform Kata:

- with yellow belts – not higher than Heian 1
- with orange / red belts – not higher than Heian 2
- with green belts – not higher than Heian 3
- with blue / violet belts – not higher than Heian 4-5
- with brown belts – not higher than Bassai Dai

The Katas are to be performed according the following regulations:

In **Team Kata** only one kata is required (Heian 1- 5, Bassai Dai, Jion, Kanku Dai, Empi) in the final round bunkai has to be applied. In age categories 2008–2009 and 2010 and later mixed teams (girls and boys) are allowed, but if the number of only-girls-teams in that age category is three or more, mixed teams will compete together with only-boys-teams.

In **Enbu** gong in 55th second and in 65th second; penalty for passing the time limit. Evaluation by the point system.

In **Kumite** children compete in different types of training Kumite:

The Defence can execute any blocking action. In Kikhon-Ippon and Jiu-Ippon Ko-go Kumite the Offence has 10 seconds to perform the attack (if the attack was not performed in due time the Shu-shin announces "Jikan!" and the Defence gets 2 scores). All terms, gestures for judges, points and penalties used are from Ko-go Kumite WTKF Competition Rules. The competitors don't announce and confirm the attacks orally.

Participants in age category 2010 and later and participants with **lower Kyus** in all age children categories (2004 and later) will perform only – Kikhon Kumite (long distance).

What is Kikhon-Kumite (long distance)?

The distance between the opponents is 3 m, thus they don't touch each other. The Offence executes an attack, the Defence executes a blocking action and a counter-attack. A proper timing and quality of the techniques performed are being examined and bring scores.

What is Jiu-Ippon Ko-go Kumite?

This type of Kumite is Jiu-Ippon Kumite proceeded using the terms, gestures, scores and penalties used in Ko-go Kumite. The match consists of 6 episodes with both sides being the Offence three times. See the list of attacking actions. In case of a draw Kettei-sen match is to be held, in which both sides perform Keri attacking actions (see the list).
